

# **Iconic Rock Band Boston Makes Only New York City Area Appearance This Season At The Westchester County Center, White Plains**

**Boston will embark on its first tour in nearly four years starting this June**

## **Tickets on Sale March 16th**

White Plains, NY - February 29, 2012 - What's the occasion? Tom Scholz says his band wants to play some shows before December, just in case the Mayans were right about the whole end of the world thing.

"Just 10 months till the end ... at least till the end of the Mayan calendar anyway," Scholz said in an announcement on Boston's website. "I wonder, did they mean to prophesize the end of the world, or was the December 21st planetary alignment just a convenient place to stop chiseling stone tablets on a really long calendar project? Some people think it is the same thing, so why take a chance? If I was making a bucket list, it would definitely include going out one more time to play some Boston shows – before time runs out!

"So just to be safe, we are going to do exactly that. I don't really think the world is going to end this year, but on the off chance the Mayans were on to something, let me take a moment to thank all of you for helping make the Boston experience an awesome ride. One of the best things about Boston to me is its fans; they are some of the nicest people I've ever met, and collectively the best crowds anyone could wish to play for."

The 2012 tour begins June 28 in Hollywood, Fla., at the Seminole Hard Rock Live. Headline dates are booked through a July 28 show in London, Ontario, at Harris Park, followed by an Aug. 1 appearance at the Ohio State Fair in Columbus, Ohio, and an Aug. 12 set at Bethlehem Musikfest in Bethlehem, Pa.

"An Evening With Boston" is the second event in the Westchester County Center for concert promoter Westchester Media, who will unveil an acoustics renovation in the

WCC's Main Hall by the famed Walters-Storyk engineering firm in time for The Beach Boys 50<sup>th</sup> Anniversary Tour on May 15<sup>th</sup>. The event is also the second performance of the newly dubbed "Pepé Infiniti Concert Series." Pepé Infiniti is the largest Infiniti dealer in the U.S. and moves into its new showroom on Central Avenue near the County Center this coming April 5<sup>th</sup>.
